



Tennessee School Bus Driver Hall of Fame Requirements (2020 Revision)

- School Bus-Driver(s) with the most continuous years-of-service with a single school district.
- Honored during the Annual Conference President's Awards Dinner.
- The honoree(s) will receive a plaque signifying his or her achievement.
- The honoree(s) will receive an proper gift signifying his or her achievement.
- Complimentary Family TAPT Conference Registration.
- Free (2) Conference Rate nights lodging at the Music Road Hotel in Pigeon Forge. Only (1) one room will be provided-Conference Rate-(2) Queen Beds)
- The school district must have at least (1) one active TAPT Member to *submit* a candidate for consideration by the TAPT Board.
- New Nominations will be needed each year, nominations will not be "carried over from previous years".
- Only Three (3) HOF winners will be selected. One (1) from each of the Grand Divisions of Tennessee (see the grand division map)
- Since all candidates are certainly deserving and to be fair statewide, School Districts with no prior winners will have first consideration and first priority.
- The TAPT Board may select more than one candidate from a grand division if no entry is received for an individual grand division.
- An active TAPT Member District will have registered as a conference attendee at last year's conference. Registration Records will determine membership.
- The years-of-service will be each school year completed with a single school district or head start program.
- The years-of-service do not have to be continuous but must be with the same school district unless an exception is granted by the TAPT Board of Directors.
- If selected, the candidate's Supervisor must present documents signed by the human resources department of the school district as proof of employment.
- Candidates must be active school bus drivers not retired school bus drivers.
